#### SERMON STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Read John 4:27-42. This passage comes right after Jesus has spoken to the woman at the well. (If you need to read the whole story for context, start at 4:1.) The disciples went out looking for food. What does Jesus say His food is? And how should this shape the way we share the Gospel with others?
2. The Samaritan Woman shared her faith by sharing the "real" her with people she knew (her village, v. 28-30). Where are there people in your life that need to know the Gospel?
3. If you are a follower of Jesus, what percentage of people that you regularly interact with do you think know you're a Christian?
4. What is in the way of you being more public about your faith? Are there specific contexts or relationships you notice you are more private about it?
5. One simple way to be more transparent about your faith is to share how Jesus affects your viewpoint on your Problems, Preferences, and Priorities. These are all things we pretty normally talk about with other people. How is your perspective on these affected by Jesus? Do you think you could mention that in conversation with other people?
6. Who is someone in your life you can point to Jesus? How will you do that over the next two weeks?
