GOD IN SUFFERING: EXODUS 3

SERMON STUDY QUESTIONS

1. When you're going through hard times, or you know someone going through hard times, how can that make it harder to share the Gospel?
2. Has anyone ever shared Scripture or Gospel truth with you during a time of suffering? How did that go?
3. In Exodus, Moses tried being the savior of his people by murdering an Egyptian, and it didn't turn out well. When you or someone else is suffering, how are you tempted to view yourself as the one who needs to fix the problem?

Activity/Passages

In Exodus 3, Moses realizes God is the Savior, not Him. God actually listens, God has a plan, and He is with His people. These are all things we can forget or have a hard time believing when we are suffering. What is a verse or passage that has been helpful to you during a time of struggle? Take a few minutes to find a passage, and answer these questions:

1. What truth(s) does this passage show you about God?
2. How can this help someone going through suffering? (How has it helped you?)

If you can't think of a passage, here are some suggested passages to look at:

Psalm 40; Psalm 42; Psalm 46; Matthew 11:27-30; Romans 5:1-11; Romans 8:18-39; Philippians 4:6-8; Hebrews 4:14-16; Hebrews 12; 1 Peter 1:3-12; 1 Peter 5:6-11

ENDING PRAYER/APPLICATION

What do you really need to believe from the passages today? Is there anyone in your life you can encourage with a truth that is encouraging you?
