

RESkids will also be taking the following extra precautions until this cold/flu/virus season has passed:

- BK has removed all fabric toys
- Toys will be separated by services and will be sanitized
- all games/activities have been written to eliminate contact
- teachers trained to look for symptoms of cold/cough then call service lead or director to assess
- clorox wiping surfaces in between activities throughout all 3 services
- Prevention of entrance and dismissal of any children showing signs of illness (please be aware that in order to keep the children in RESkids in a safe and healthy space, we will be calling parents to pick up children who are showing symptoms of Covid-19 as described by the CDC: fever, coughing, shortness of breath. We thank you now for your compliance and understanding)

To help keep RESkids healthy and safe, we ask all families to:

- Wash hands with liquid soap and water and rub for at least 20 seconds;
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when coughing or sneezing;
- Refrain from touching your eyes, nose and mouth;
- Stay home when you are sick; and
- Get a flu shot to protect yourself and others from the flu, which has similar symptoms to COVID-19.
