PERSONAL REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. Where do you notice in yourself a tendency to approach church like a consumer or like it's about making you happy?
2. Have you noticed areas where you ignore Biblical teaching so you can live the way you want? It could be ignoring a command to do something, or a command to *not* do something.
3. Read 1 Corinthians 12. You're a vital part of the church family who God made for a purpose. Where do you have trouble believing this? What gifts or talents has God given you that you might use to live out His purpose for you in the church?
