FIGHT: WHO IS THE DEVIL?- EPHESIANS 6:10-13

These questions are for you to use on your own, or with a small group, to engage with the ideas from Sunday's sermon. We encourage you to journal responses to them, or gather with others (from your MC, or not) and discuss these questions while praying for each other.

Golden Thread: Satan is a created being who is constantly trying to harm us. However, as God's children, God has empowered us to overcome his schemes.

Memory Verse: "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places." - Ephesians 6:12

PERSONAL REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. We often think the Devil has god-like powers. However, the Devil is a created being. How do you need to change your view of the Devil today? What did you believe about him before that was corrected by Pastor Ryan's sermon?
2. Read Ephesians 6:10-12. Verse 11 specifically talks about the schemes of the Devil. Pastor Ryan reminded us that the Devil disguises himself as an angel of light. This means that Satan can often trick us into believing something evil is good. Can you think of ways you've been tricked this last week? Has this scheme hurt one of your relationships?
3. Read verse 13. God has given us the ability to withstand Satan's attacks. We are called to resist and repent. Which one of those might God want you to work on this week? What would it look like for you to do that?
