- 1) If you had to use three words or phrases to describe yourself, what would they be, and why are they important?
- 2) What do you remember about Pastor Jason's sermon that stood out, was new, or hard to accept?

Summary: The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the focal point of Christianity. Without it, everything else falls. Because it is true, the resurrection of Jesus has called us into a new identity with new challenges and opportunities which invites us into a better story. We experience all three of these things in discipleship to Jesus. His grace and love towards us are so immense that we are compelled to respond in devotion to Him.

- 3) One of the key points of Pastor Jason's sermon was how the resurrection invites us into a better and bigger story than we could experience on our own; that was get to play a part in God's massive plan of redemption being played out. How might being a part of God's massive plan have an effect on the way that we make plans for our lives?
- 4) Pastor Jason referenced several ways we sometimes try to form our identity (job, relationships, parenting, money, sexual satisfaction, political ideology, etc). Give an example from your own life of something that you have a tendency to make your identity.
- 5) Discipleship often creates tension between us and the world. To give ourselves completely to Jesus means living a different kind of life than the rest of the world. Give an example of how you have experienced this tension.
- 6) Read Galatians 2:20. What do you think Paul means when he says, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God." and how do you think 'Christ living in us' leads to a "filled life?"
- 7) Pastor Jason gave several examples of how our new identity in Jesus changes the way we live our lives. Give examples of how your identity in Christ has impacted your life and/or areas of your life that you want to see changed.
